**'Callous officials shatter man's dream of returning home'**

SLIGO County Council planning officials have been accused of "callousness" after a returned emigrant criticised the council for refusing to build a home on his land in the Glencara area.

An angry Senator Willie Farrell has claimed the man's lifelong dream of returning home from England has been shattered by "callous council bureaucrats".

At a meeting of the council, Senator Farrell claimed the man in question had been granted a two previous occasions but it had not been refused. He attacked the Council for being too slow in processing the interests of tourists" at a time when the Council would not provide public facilities in the recognised tourist attractions in the county.

During the debate it was also claimed that the man would now have to return to London "to live in a hovel".

**Disappointed**

Senator Farrell said he was very disappointed the planning permission had not been granted. This was the year that President Robinson thought it worthwhile to the two houses of the O'Reachtas together to address them on the rights of emigrants, and it was the only time the Government was giving consideration to the idea of giving emigrants seats in the Dáil. It was also a year that Sligo County Council refused planning permission to a native Irish emigrant.

He had received planning permission a number of years ago, but under the auspices of the then county engineer who was now the county manager, and it was so good enough then, it should be good enough now.

The time was fast approaching when planning meetings would have to be held in public so that the public at large would know what was happening.

Maybe the problem was that planning decisions were no longer made by the Council's engineers, and there now seemed to be a strong case for having planning revert to the planning department, Cr. Conway advised.

**Classic case**

According to Cr. Paddy Conway, this was a classic case of doctors differ and patients disagree. Planning permission granted in this case in the past had been under the auspices of the then county engineer who was now the county manager, and it was so good enough then, it should be good enough now.

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Maybe the problem was that planning decisions were no longer made by the Council's engineers, and there now seemed to be a strong case for having planning revert to the planning department, Cr. Conway advised.

**Damage**

Indeed, a wall at Croswell was now contaminated because hundreds of tourists had nowhere else to go but to the wall. It was more damage to tourism than a three-bedroom house in Glencara could ever do, he said.

Senator Farrell said he was even more hurt by the callousness of the Council officials who made the decision based on the interests of scenic areas, while there were well polluted, and they would not put up a toilet.

**Scapogals**

Proposing that the Council should be "realistic" in the way it used toilet facilities for tourists, Senator Farrell said it was time to stop making proposals out of "wish emigrants".

The Council's decision to refuse the planning application was described as "outrageous" by Cr. Conway. He should be welcoming people back from London rather than driving them away.

This sort of thing was beginning to happen in the county, and it was outrageous that a man who was born and bred in Glencara was now being asked to leave the latter part of his life there.

Asking that the situation be reviewed, Senator Farrell said the question would have no option but to go back to London to "live in a hovel", because that was the only accommodation he would get there.

Cr. Michael Carroll recalled that he had supported the applicant on two occasions when the application originally came before the Council.

However, when he visited the site he could find favour with the views expressed by the planning officials, as it was one of the most picturesque and scenic areas around Glencara.

But it was his very beauty which made it attractive as a site for a house, and in view of the fact that planning permission had not been granted on two previous occasions he would support the applicant on this occasion. If it was correct to grant permission on two previous occasions, it should be correct now, he maintained.

Responding to the councillor, County Manager, Mr. Sean Stewart, agreed that there were parts of the county which caused difficulties with planning permission. There were certain areas which were "sensitive" and sometimes applications did not meet with the Council's aspirations.

He pointed out that the Council's general purposes meetings had originally been set up so that councillors could consider privately and visit particular sites and reach a decision.

He felt it was a pity that a man to meet applicants on the site to discuss the various problems involved in a situation could be found.

Saying there was little point in attacking officials without visiting the site, he said that he was disappointed in this case that some councillors had made allegations without even knowing where the site was.
