

Irish girls can buy 'morning after' pill in North

IRISH women will be able to bypass an over the counter ban on the morning after pill - by travelling to the North.

Earlier this week the British Government gave the go-ahead for the pills to be sold without prescription to all girls aged over 16.

But their Irish counterparts still refuse to allow the pills be sold over

the counter on demand. Any woman needing emergency contraception must go to her doctor and get a prescription.

However from January 1, 2001, chemists in the Six Counties will sell the emergency contraception for £20 a time. And countless Southern women are

set to stock up on the pill. Indeed they can visit Northern pharmacies again and again without question.

"The most sensible thing to do is to get a packet in advance and keep it in the medicine cupboard," says Ann Furedi, director of the British Pregnancy Advisory Service (BPAS).

Opponents have called the decision to sell the drug over the counter as "a licence for promiscuity".

They claim it will encourage casual sex and an increase in sexually transmitted diseases. They also fear that underage girls will be able to obtain the pills.

And there is concern about possible side effects caused by the high levels of hormone in the pill - as much as six ordinary contraceptive pills.

However groups including the BPAS dismiss such health fears, describing

the pills as "safer than a packet of aspirin you can pick up from a supermarket shelf".

And the group insists that the pills are not an abortion method, pointing out that "if you are already pregnant, they simply will not work."

Currently Ireland and Greece are the only two countries in Europe not to sell the pills over the counter.

tial arts expert Oliver Whitcomb, will also be upset by the sizzling colour pictures.

In the past, Demi and Bruce paid out more than \$1million to photographers in an attempt to stop the raunchiest of the pictures, which first appeared in Europe, being published in America.

But already, some are popping up on the Net. And Demi's fears are flooding back. For the shocking shots are definitely rated XXX.

A source said: "Absolutely nothing is left to the imagination. The pictures are so brazen, it is absolutely startling. Demi is very beautiful, but her poses are porno-

graphic."

In other nude pictures, taken at a different time, Demi is topless while the rest of her body is artfully concealed.

The raunchiest of the photographs were published in the German edition of Playboy in 1983. The bare-breasted shots appeared in the French magazine Oui.

The sexiest pictures, say insiders, couldn't be used in America at the time because they were too revealing and Demi was only 17 when they were taken.

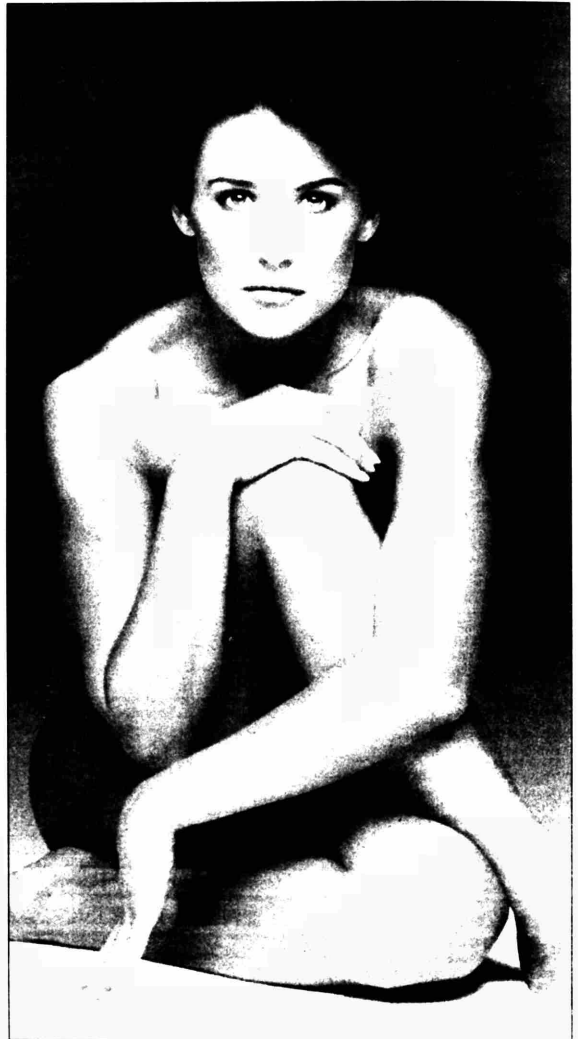
One source explained: "Now, anybody who gets hold of that old German magazine can circulate them on the Internet. The fear that they're turning up is gnawing away at Demi."

The stunningly beautiful actress is terrified that the pictures will be seen by her daughters - 12-year-old Rumer, Scout, aged nine, and Tallulah, six. She also fears the girls' friends will ogle at the pictures on the Internet and tease her daughters.

Early in her career, Demi was a member of Hollywood's hard-partying Brat Pack. This also included Emilio Estevez, Judd Nelson and Sly Stone. A friend said: "The young girl coming to Hollywood were doing these pictures."

Demi tells pals she was a "very vulnerable" and didn't think twice when she posed for them. She was an unknown. Demi didn't meet Willis 27 years later, so when he came awake from a coma, she was about

Another pal added: "Now Demi has three young daughters and her responsibilities as a mother have increased since she divorced Bruce. She knows those darned pictures are out there somewhere, and she doesn't want her girls to see them."

start a bonfire with them. Then she would know they'd be gone for ever."

Demi confided to her pals that these aren't pictures she is proud of. They're photographs of a young girl who made a mistake by posing for them while she was trying to get her big break in Hollywood.

The actress let the bra-

ried Bruce, put her wild ways behind her. Now she is living the life of a small-town mother and housewife in the Idaho village of Hailey.

An insider said: "Demi's man, Oliver, doesn't want the general public to see sensational shots of a young and nubile Demi when she may soon become his bride."
